All select grade doors will have random width panel staves with color and grain matching being the main difference between the natural and select grades. Afrormosia-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a golden brown blend of sapwood and heartwood throughout. This grade is only available with a Natural (<i>no stain</i>) finish. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Afrormosia-Select	Natural characteristics common within this species will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than with the natural grades. This grade is only available with a Natural (<i>no stain</i>) finish. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Alder-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a blend of reddish brown sapwood and heartwood throughout the product. This product is most desirable for a medium to dark stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Alder-Rustic	This unique species will have many variations allowed. Mineral, sap and knots are common. Color may vary from a light tan sapwood to a reddish brown heartwood blended throughout. Knot size and the percentage of mineral, sapwood and heartwood are <u>not allowed to be specified by the customer</u> . All materials will be structurally sound, knots may have voids but no visible light will show through. Alder-Select	Natural characteristics common within this species will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than with our natural grade. This grade will be uniform in color and grain matched. Ash-Budget	This “Price Point Product” may contain some narrow staves, sapwood, heartwood, pin knots and all other natural characteristics commonly found within this species. This grade will not be color and grain matched, but will be structurally sound and should prove to be a good value for your dollar. Expect a large range of color throughout the entire order. This grade is most desirable for medium to dark stain colors, but do expect some color variations from stave to stave due to the makeup of the raw material. Bamboo-Blond-Flat Grain - 3/4" only	Natural characteristics common within this specie will result in a light blond color. Flat grain represents a type of construction in which bamboo slats are laminated face up to form a multi-layered solid plank with no internal voids. The resulting look will have no cross grain plies and the grain will run in the same direction. This product is most desirable when using a natural finish. Bamboo-Caramelized-Flat Grain - 3/4" only	Characteristics common within this specie will result in an amber color achieved by a process of pressure-heating the bamboo slats to “brown” the sugar compounds naturally present in the plant. Flat grain represents a type of construction in which bamboo slats are laminated face up to form a multi-layered solid plank with no internal voids. The resulting look will have no cross grain plies and the grain will run in the same direction. This product is most desirable when using a natural finish. Beech-European Steamed-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a blend of brown to reddish brown heartwood and a light brown sapwood throughout the product. This product is most desirable for a medium to dark stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Beech-European Steamed-Select	Natural characteristics common within this species will be monitored under closer guidelines than with the natural grade. This grade will be uniform in color and grain matched. This grade is highly recommended when using a natural or light stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Birch-Mixed	Natural colors common in this species are allowed, which results in a mixture of sap and light heartwood blended throughout the product. We recommend a “Spray No Wipe” stain process when using this specie. This grade is most desirable for a natural or light stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Birch-Natural	Natural characteristics common in this species are allowed, which results in a mixture of sap and light heartwood blended throughout the product. A small percentage of mineral and flecks will be allowed on the face and in profiled areas. We recommend a “Spray No Wipe” stain process when using this specie. This grade is most desirable for a medium to dark stain. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Birch-Paint / Budget	This “Price Point Product” may contain some narrow staves, sapwood, heartwood, pin knots and all other natural characteristics commonly found within this species. This grade will not be color and grain matched, but will be structurally sound and should prove to be a good value for your dollar. Expect a large range of color throughout the entire order. This grade is most desirable for medium to dark stain colors, but do expect some color variations from stave to stave due to the makeup of the raw material. This grade is highly recommended when using a natural to light stain color. Birch-White-Select	Natural characteristics common within this species will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than with our natural grade. This grade is highly recommended when using a natural to light stain color. Butternut-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a blend of light brown heartwood and light colored sapwood throughout. This product is most desirable for a medium to dark stain color. Butternut-Select	Natural characteristics within this species will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than with the natural grade. This grade will be uniform in color and grain matched. Cherry-Gummy	Natural characteristics such as pin knots and sap will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than our natural grade. This grade purposely includes pitch pockets distributed throughout the product. A small percentage of mineral will be allowed. Pin knots are allowed on the face and in profiled areas of the product. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Cherry-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed. This results in a mixture of sap, light heartwood and pitch pockets blended throughout. A small percentage of mineral will be allowed on the face and in profiled areas. Pin knots are allowed on the face and in profiled areas of the product. This grade is most desirable for medium to dark stain colors. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Cherry-No Sap (NS)-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed, but no sap is allowed on the face of the product. Sap which might appear in profiled areas is allowed in small amounts. Natural characteristics like pin knots, pitch pockets and a small percentage of mineral will be allowed on the face and in profiled areas. We feel this grade is acceptable for use with a “clear” natural finish, but may be enhanced with a light cherry colored stain. Cherry-Rustic	This unique species will have many variations allowed. Pitch, mineral, sapwood, heartwood and knots are common. Color variations may range from white in the sapwood area to a deep red in the heartwood area. Pin knots are allowed on the face and in profiled areas of the product. Knot size and the percentage of pitch, sapwood, heartwood and number of knots are <u>not allowed to be specified by the customer</u> . All material will be structurally sound, knots may have voids but no visible light will show through. Cherry-Select	Natural characteristics common within this species will be monitored under closer quality guidelines than with our natural grade. This grade will be uniform in color and grain match. A smaller percentage of mineral and pitch pockets will be allowed. Occasional pin knots are allowed on the face and in profiled areas of the product. This grade is highly recommended when using a natural or light stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Cherry-Ultra-Rustic	This grade is everything that our rustic grade is and more. Please note that when using the RVSCP panel option, you may encounter knots that allow light to show through the center panel. If this is objectionable, we will expect that customers fill them with putty at their discretion. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Chestnut-Australian Wormy	Australian Wormy Chestnut is a sub-species of the Eucalyptus family. Common characteristics are mineral, pitch, pin-knots and occasional insect holes. Another feature, unique to this species, is a pronounced fire stripe in the growth ring, created when seasonal fires heat resin in the tree. Products made with Australian Wormy Chestnut are matched to display a full range of color and characteristics common to the specie. Cypress-Natural	Natural characteristics common within this specie are allowed, resulting in a blend of light and dark heartwood throughout the product. A small percentage of mineral and pitch pockets will be allowed. This product is most desirable for a dark stain color. Elm-Red	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a blend of pale to reddish brown heartwood and a light brown sapwood throughout the product. This specie is most desirable for a medium to dark stain color. Due to the low volume of orders for this specie, it is not available in various grades like most other WalzCraft products. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.

* *Special Note About All Cherry & Lyptus Products*

Due to the natural photosensitive darkening process, we advise that you finish Cherry & Lyptus products immediately upon receipt. Should you find this to happen, simply exposing the doors to natural direct sunlight will help to result in more even shading. *Traces of shadowing (darkening) may be visible, and considered acceptable, on the back sides of product.* This natural darkening process does occur on Sample Color Blocks also, and we urge you to order a new sample so your customer is aware of the differences that can be expected in a newly manufactured product and that of product that has begun to naturally age.

Fir-Douglas-Straight Grain	Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which results in a mixture of heartwood and sapwood ranging in color from light yellow to reddish brown. Within the woodworking industry, you might refer to this species as Douglas Fir VG (Vertical Grain). In matching this specie we are primarily focused on maintaining the vertical grain look. We strive to keep the number of growth rings per inch at 7 or greater. We recommend that you view a sample on our Web Site at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Hickory-Brown-Rustic	This unique species is matched entirely of heartwood. Mineral and knots are common. Knot size and the percentage of mineral and knots are <u>not allowed to be specified by the customer</u> . All materials will be structurally sound, knots may have voids but no visible light will show through. Hickory and Pecan are members of the Walnut family and are so closely related that individual specimens cannot be identified with any certainty. We recommend that you view a sample on our Web Site at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Hickory-Brown-Select	This grade is selected from the heartwood of the hickory species. It will be a uniform mixture of brown to dark brown blended throughout. Hickory and Pecan are members of the Walnut family and are so closely related that individual specimens cannot be identified with any certainty. We recommend that you view a sample on our Web Site at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Hickory-Budget	This “Price Point Product” may contain some narrow staves, sapwood, heartwood, pin knots and all other natural characteristics commonly found within this species. This grade will not be color and grain matched, but will be structurally sound and should prove to be a good value for your dollar. Expect a large range of color throughout the entire order. Jatoba-(Brazilian Cherry)	<p>Natural characteristics common within this species are allowed which will result in a blend of pale to reddish brown heartwood and light brown heartwood throughout the product. Sapwood is not allowed in this specie. This specie is most desirable for a medium to dark stain color. Due to the low volume of orders for this specie, it is not available in various grades like most other WalzCraft products. We recommend that you view a sample on our Web Site at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.</p>
Lyptus-Budget	<p>This “Price Point Product” may contain some narrow staves, sapwood, heartwood, pin knots and all other natural characteristics commonly found within this species. This grade will not be color and grain matched, but will be structurally sound and should prove to be a good value for your dollar. Expect a large range of color throughout the entire order. This grade is most desirable for medium to dark stain colors, but do expect some color variations from stave to stave due to the makeup of the raw material. This grade will have a uniform color and grain match. This grade is highly recommended when using a natural to light stain color. We recommend that you view a sample on our Web Site at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.</p>
Maple-Hard-Birds Eye-Natural	<p>This is the recommended grade to select if you want product with the most abundant Bird's Eye in it, and if willing to accept some color variation. Our primary focus when matching this grade is to make sure that plenty of Bird's Eye are visible in the final product. This species can be somewhat compared to Maple-Hard-Natural, but with a somewhat greater color variation; including all colors of sapwood and possibly some heartwood, to achieve the Birdseye look. We do recommend a “Clear Natural Finish” when using this specie so that the Bird's Eyes don't get masked over by the stain color. If a stain color is required, a light colored “Spray No Wipe” finish would be recommended. Maple-Hard-Birds Eye-Select	<p>We have two main focuses when matching this grade. First we focus on delivering as many Bird's Eyes in the final product as humanly possible, and secondly we focus on keeping color variation to a minimum. This grade will have “noticeably fewer” Bird's Eyes than our Maple-Hard-Birdseye-Natural grade. Due to the lack of heartwood in this product, fewer Bird's Eyes are produced. This species can be compared to Maple-Hard-Select, but with a greater color variation due to carefully selecting sapwood with a variety of colors to achieve the Birdseye look. We recommend a “Clear Natural Finish” whenever using this species so that the Bird's Eyes don't get masked over by the stain color. If a stain color is required, a light colored “Spray No Wipe” finish would be recommended. Maple-Hard-Mixed	<p>Natural colors common within this species are allowed, which results in a mixture of sap and heartwood blended throughout the product. Maple-Hard-Natural-Straight Grain	Natural characteristics common within this specie are allowed, which results in a mixture of mostly sapwood and small amounts of heartwood. The straight grain in this species will be a blend of rift and quarter sawn throughout the product. A small percentage of mineral will be allowed on the face and in profiled areas. We recommend a “Spray No Wipe” stain process when using this specie. This grade is most desirable for medium to dark stain colors. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
Maple-Hard-Rustic	This unique species will have many variations allowed. Mineral and knots are common. Color variations may range in the sapwood areas from white to grayish brown. Some heartwood may also be included. Knot size and the percentage of mineral and knots are <u>not allowed to be specified by the customer</u> . All materials will be structurally sound, knots may have voids but no visible light will show through. We recommend that you view a sample on our <i>Web Site</i> at WalzCraft.com, click on the Resources tab, or order a sample for your own use.
